Our Edgy Veggie columnist, **Ellen Kanner**, shares this discovery:

In hard times like these, people turn to . . . doughnuts. At least that's what the folks at **Mandarin Gourmet Donut Shoppe** are betting on. The owner, **Michelle Vazquez**, is not Mandarin, but Latina, and there's no shop -- these doughnuts come to your door. Delivery is available Monday, Wednesday and Friday in metropolitan Miami-Dade.

Choose from 10 varieties of glazed doughnuts (\$1.55-\$1.75), a dozen kinds of filled doughnuts (\$1.99) and a half-dozen doughnut "dots" (60 cents) in flavors like cocoa-hazelnut, dark chocolate and lemon-chamomille. Ingredients are organic when possible, the website promises. As for flavor, "I personally do not doughnut, but my father and husband have partaken and give a hearty thumbs-up," Kanner reports.
